This website is owned and operated by Microvascular Therapeutics, LLC. ("MVT", "we", "our" or "us"). The materials on our website (the "website" or the "site") are provided by MVT as a service to our customers and the general public and are to be used for informational purposes only.

MVT respects the privacy of visitors to our website, and we recognize the importance of taking steps to protect the privacy of information we collect via our website. This Privacy Policy describes the types of Personal Data (as defined below) we collect about visitors to the website, how we may use the Personal Data and with whom we may share it. This Privacy Policy also describes (1) the measures we take to safeguard the Personal Data we collect and (2) your rights and privileges concerning our collection, use, and disclosure of your Personal Data.

Exclusions

This policy only addresses Personal Data collected through this website. It does not describe the ways in which we may collect or use Personal Data obtained offline, and it does not address or control the privacy practices of other websites (including those we link to), which may have their own policies. We encourage our website users to be aware when they leave our website and to read the privacy statements of each and every website they visit that collects Personal Data. Unsolicited information you provide to us may be deemed to be non-confidential and MVT will be free to reproduce, use, disclose, and distribute such unsolicited information to others without permission, compensation, limitation or attribution.

By accessing our website, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy and to the Terms and Conditions of Use. If you do not agree to these terms, you are not authorized to use our website.

Introduction

"Personal Data" is data that can be used to identify or contact you, such as your contact details, including your name, address, e-mail address, country, and telephone number, any other information that may be listed on your resume in the event that you submit a job application to MVT via our website, and, where provided for under applicable law, any data about your use of our website or your device that may be collected automatically, including through the use of cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies.

We will handle your Personal Data in accordance with applicable law and in line with the following principles:

We will process Personal Data lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.

- We will only collect Personal Data for a specified, explicit and legitimate purpose, and we will only use personal information for the purposes for which it was originally collected.
- We will limit collection of Personal Data to the extent necessary in relation to the purpose for which they are processed.
- We will make reasonable efforts to ensure that your Personal Data is accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date.

- We will store Personal Data for no longer than is necessary for the purpose for which the Personal Data are processed.
- Personal Data will only be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal information.

Our privacy practices are described in greater detail in the remainder of this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect

You may visit our website without affirmatively providing any information about yourself. If you choose to submit your information through the the “Contact Us” features on our website or if you apply for a job opening with MVT via the “Careers” section of our website, we may ask you to provide Personal Data, such as your name, address, telephone number and e-mail address, job title, company name, country, information about your job role and any other job-related information. You are not obligated to provide any Personal Data to MVT, but your ability to use our website or its features and your ability to apply for an employment position may be limited if you do not.

Personal Data About Use of the Website Collected by Cookies or Other Automated means

When you use our website, we may automatically collect information about your use of the website, including through the use of cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies (“automated information”). Automated information may include device information such as IP address, device identifiers, and operating system, as well as usage information such as time and duration of use, interaction with content, information stored in cookies or similar technologies. Pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679 on data protection (the “GDPR”), automated information is considered personal data, and we will treat such automated information as Personal Data in accordance with this privacy policy.

“Cookies” are small files that the website places on your hard drive for identification purposes. These files are used for website registration and for customization of your next time visit to our website. For example, cookies will remember your preferred language and display. Cookies cannot read data off of your hard drive.

We use the following cookies on our website:

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into your job applicant account.
- Functionality cookies. These are used to recognize you when you return to our website and to embed functionality from third party services. This enables us to personalize our content for you, remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language) and to integrate useful services provided by third party providers into our website.

- Analytical cookies. We use the Google Analytics platform to collect certain analytical information to help us better understand activity on our website and improve our services and the quality of our website. This information includes the IP address, page requests, referring websites or ads, operating system and browser, and time spent on our website. We receive this data in an aggregated form. We use this information to help us understand how visitors engage with our website, measure the effectiveness of our advertising on third-party websites, and to improve our visitors' experience.

Personal Data From Third-Party Sources

Aggregated Data

We may aggregate and/or de-identify any Personal Data that we collect, such that the information no longer identifies any specific individual. We may use, disclose and otherwise process such information for our own legitimate business purposes – including historical and statistical analysis and business planning – without restriction.

How We Use Personal Data

We may use Personal Data for the following purposes.

Our legitimate interests

We may process your Personal Data where it is necessary for our legitimate interest as a company, including to manage, promote and improve our business and manage our risk. For example, we may process your Personal Data to:

- provide you with information you requested and/or to respond to your inquiries submitted via the website, email and/or phone,
- facilitate our recruitment activities (such as processing employment applications, evaluating you as a job candidate for an employment activity, and monitoring our recruitment statistics),

- analyze and enhance our communications and strategies (including by identifying when emails sent to you have been received and read),
- tailor the content we display on our website,
- protect against, identify, investigate and respond to fraud, illegal activity (such as incidents of hacking or misuse of our website) and claims and other liabilities,
- maintain the privacy, security, safety or property of the website, and

Legal obligation

We may be required by law to collect and process certain Personal Data about you. For example, we may need to process your Personal Data to comply with our contractual obligations to the U.S. government as a government contractor.

Your consent

We may also seek, either directly or through our trusted third parties, your separate consent to process your Personal Data, for example, when you choose to receive MVT news and updates from us, or for the use of non-essential cookies.

If we have sought your consent to process your Personal Data, you may subsequently withdraw it at any time by contacting us at the address listed in the “Your Privacy Rights” section below.

Sharing of Personal data

We will not sell, share, or otherwise distribute your Personal Data to third parties except as provided in this Privacy Policy.

Affiliates and Service Providers

We may disclose your Personal Data to other MVT affiliates worldwide that agree to treat it in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We may also transfer Personal Data to service providers who act for or on our behalf for further processing, such as evaluating the usefulness of this website, data management, technical support or recruiting data analysis. These service providers have contracted with us to only use the Personal Data for the purpose(s) for which the data were originally collected or may otherwise be lawfully processed, not to sell your Personal Data to other third parties, and not to disclose it to other third parties except as may be required by law, as permitted by us or as stated in this Privacy Policy.

Other Parties in Connection with a Corporate Transaction

We may also transfer Personal data we collected from you to a third party as part of a corporate business transaction such as a merger, acquisition, reorganization, joint venture, financing or sale of our assets.

Other Parties when Required by Applicable Law or As Necessary to Protect MVT. We may disclose Personal Data to a third party to comply with legal and regulatory requirements, or to protect against fraud, illegal activity (such as responding to incidents of hacking or misuse of our website) and claims and other liabilities.

International Data Transfers

When we share Personal Data with a third party, such data transfers may include the transfer of Personal Data to other countries. Those countries may not have the same data protection laws as the country in which the Personal Data initially originated.

EEA Residents Only

MVT, in the US, will act as a data controller and will process your Personal Data, by determining purposes and means of its processing, as per the GDPR. Please be aware that your Personal Data will reside on Aquia's servers including inside and outside of the European Union. Before transferring your Personal Data outside the EEA, we will take steps to ensure that such data will be afforded the same level of protection as under applicable data protection laws within the EEA. For data transfers outside the EEA, we use, where required, applicable safeguards, including standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission. Your Privacy Rights

You may have certain rights as a data subject under applicable law. For example, you may have the right to object to or request restriction of processing of your Personal Data and to request access to, rectification, erasure and portability of the Personal Data we hold about you, subject to certain exceptions prescribed by law. Information Security

MVT uses commercially reasonable administrative, technical, personnel-related, and physical security measures designed to safeguard the Personal Data in our possession against loss, theft and unauthorized use, disclosure, or modification. Of course, despite these measures, we cannot guarantee perfect security of the networks, servers, and databases we operate or that are operated on our behalf. In particular, email sent to or from the website may not be secure. Therefore, you should take special care in deciding what information you send to us via email. Please keep this in mind when disclosing any Personal Data to us via the website.

Data Retention

Your Personal Data will be retained by MVT only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose(s) for which it was collected, depending on the purpose(s) for which the Personal Data was collected, the nature of the Personal Data, any contractual relationship that governs the retention of the Personal Data, and our legal or regulatory obligations. We will then destroy or anonymize your Personal Data, in accordance with applicable law.
